STEP 1 – BUILD YOUR NEED / WANT LIST

List the subjects your child **needs** to study (core curriculum) and the subjects/topics they **want** to explore (interest-led). Schedule NEED subjects first — fit WANT subjects around them.

NEED – CORE SUBJECTS

eg. Maths, English, Science, History, Languages...

WANT – INTEREST-LED SUBJECTS

eg. Art history, coding, chess, geography, drama...

STEP 2 – ROUGH WEEKLY TIME ALLOCATION

How many sessions per week will each NEED subject get? Even a rough plan helps.

CORE SUBJECT + SESSIONS/WEEK

eg. Maths — 5x

CORE SUBJECT + SESSIONS/WEEK

eg. English — 5x

CORE SUBJECT + SESSIONS/WEEK

eg. Science — 3x

Term Goals by Subject

Step 3 — Set term goals for each subject

For each subject, note what you'd like your child to have covered or achieved by the end of term.

SUBJECT: *EG. MATHS*

eg. Complete fractions unit, introduce decimals

SUBJECT: *EG. ENGLISH*

eg. Finish current book, write 3 short essays

SUBJECT: *EG. SCIENCE*

eg. Complete biology module, start chemistry

SUBJECT: *EG. HISTORY*

eg. Ancient Rome unit — finish by week 8

SUBJECT: *EG. LANGUAGES*

eg. 200 new vocabulary words, past tense

SUBJECT: *EG. ART / CREATIVE*

eg. Complete portfolio piece, life drawing
